## Prairie Pilgrimage 2010 Highlights...

The second diocesan sponsored pilgrimage will focus on parishes and religious communities in northeastern North Dakota.

Tour stops include: Grand Forks, Warsaw, Grafton, Pembina, Walhalla, Langdon, Devils Lake, St. Michael and Wild Rice. We will visit the smallest Catholic Chapel in the United States plus the Catholic Indian Mission in St. Michael.



St. Stanislaus in Warsaw will be a lunch and tour stop on Friday afternoon. The group will also visit St. Gianna's Maternity Home in Warsaw.

St. Alphonsus Church in Langdon hosts one of eleven Catholic elementary schools in the Diocese of Fargo.



Above the altar of Assumption Catholic Church in Pembina is a beautiful mural of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, the patron saint of the parish.

Out on the corner of a country road sits a solitary chapel, just large enough to house an altar, a few religious artifacts, a priest and two altar servers. St. Joseph's Chapel is the smallest Catholic chapel in North Dakota. Located on the banks of the Red River of the North, it's five miles east



and one mile north of Warsaw. More than a century ago, many Polish pioneers settled around the Warsaw area; they built this chapel as a symbol of their deep Catholic faith. The pilgrims stop here Friday afternoon.
