Full implementation of our new safe environment curriculum will be effective July 1, 2012.

to attend this training IF they are responsible for implementing safe environment. In other words, it is training for the trainers. Your catechists and volunteers will receive this information from you or from your trained staff.

The annual diocesan Eucharistic procession, Walk with Christ for Life, will be held on Respect Life Sunday, October 2, at the Cathedral of St. Mary, 604 Broadway, Fargo. The day's events will begin with Holy Mass at Noon, followed by a prayerful, peaceful procession to the state's only abortion facility. A short prayer service will be held outside the abortion facility, and then those gathered will return to the Cathedral for Benediction. A lunch will be served by the Cardinal Muench Council Knights of Columbus in the church social hall after Benediction. The Walk is sponsored by the Diocese of Fargo Respect Life Office. Youth called to March for Life!

Youth in grades 9-12 from across the Diocese of Fargo are invited to participate in the 39th Annual March for Life in Washington, D.C. on January 23, 2012.
