SUBJECT: **FR. HENRY KIGGUNDU**

Your Eminence/Excellency,

The Diocese of Shreveport has advised the Conference of its concerns regarding Fr. Henry Kiggundu, a member of the Franciscan Missionaries of Hope. Fr. Kiggundu was in ministry in the Diocese of Shreveport but was released from the assignment in December 2010, because of serious misconduct. He returned to his Motherhouse in Kenya but the Diocese is advised that he now is absent from his community without permission and will not reveal his location. The Diocese also advises that Fr. Kiggundu recently made contact with a Diocese in the United States asking to be accepted for ministry. If Father Kiggundu is in the United States, it is without the sponsorship of the Diocese of Shreveport, and without the permission of his Superiors. If further information is needed contact may be made with Most Reverend Michael G. Duca, Bishop of Shreveport, or Fr. Nicholas Onyach, the Superior of the Missionaries of Hope, at mcasembo@yahoo.com. Fr. Onyach would appreciate any information about Fr. Henry Kiggundu's present whereabouts.
